The Sonoma County Transportation Authority invites proposals from qualified consultants to develop an Environmental Impact Report for the *SCTA Comprehensive Transportation Plan*.

Proposals must be submitted at or before 3:00 p.m. on May 27, 2008.

Please note submittal date has been extended by one week.

This supplemental information is provided to clarify the scope of work set forth in the RFP for the SCTA Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and to amend the schedule for proposal submittals.

Please note, the scope of work does not require the consultant to provide public outreach services. A typographical error in the original RFP cover letter indicated public outreach as a key component. However, the scope of work does not include this task.

The SCTA has a contract with The Results Group for all public outreach services associated with the Comprehensive Transportation Plan and that firm will work in conjunction with the firm selected to develop the CTP EIR.

In order to allow proposing firms adequate time to address this change, the schedule for submittal has been extended by one week. The following deadlines now apply:

Proposals Due: May 27, 2008

Interviews (if necessary): Week of June 2, 2008

Contract award: June 10, 2008 (pending SCTA approval)
